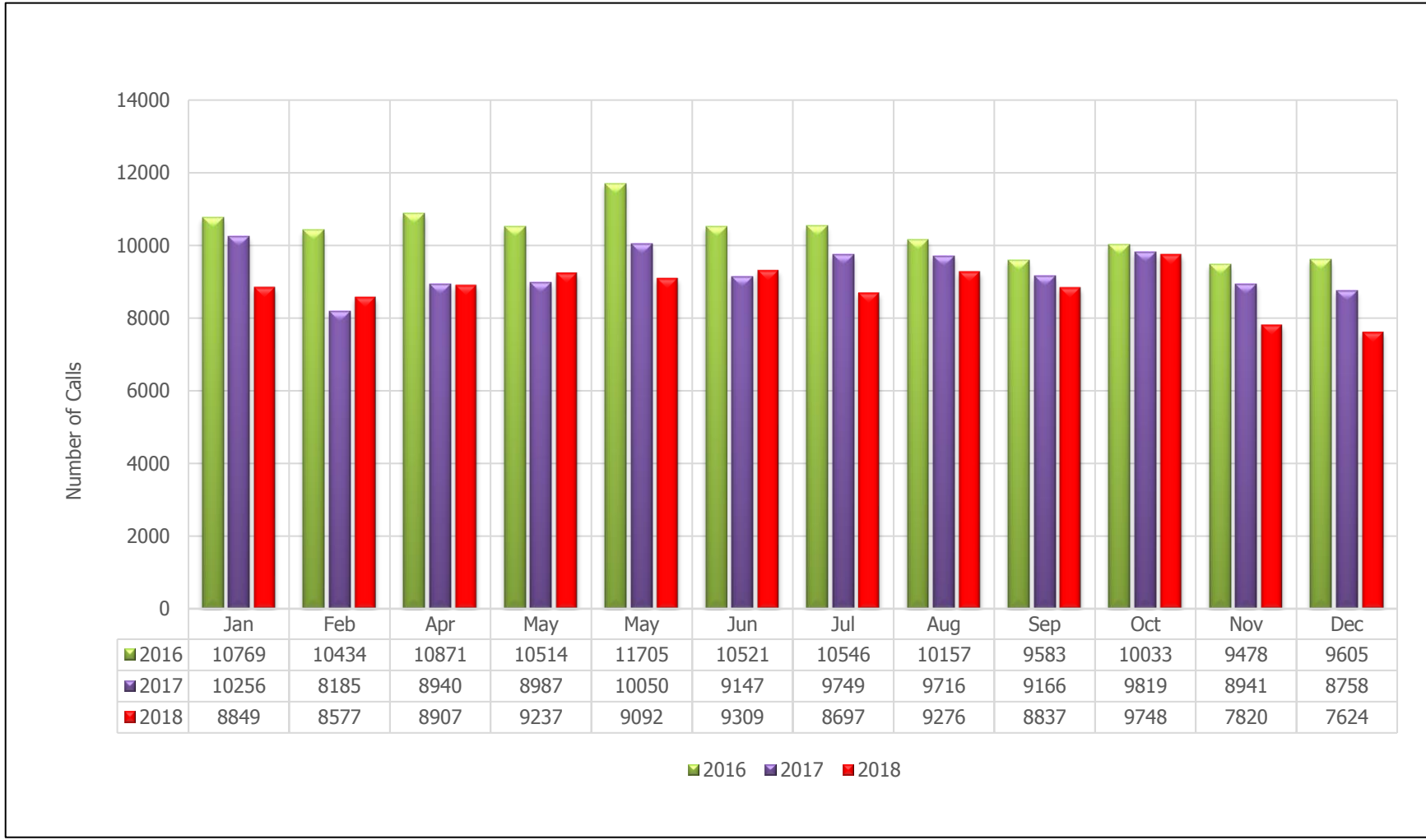

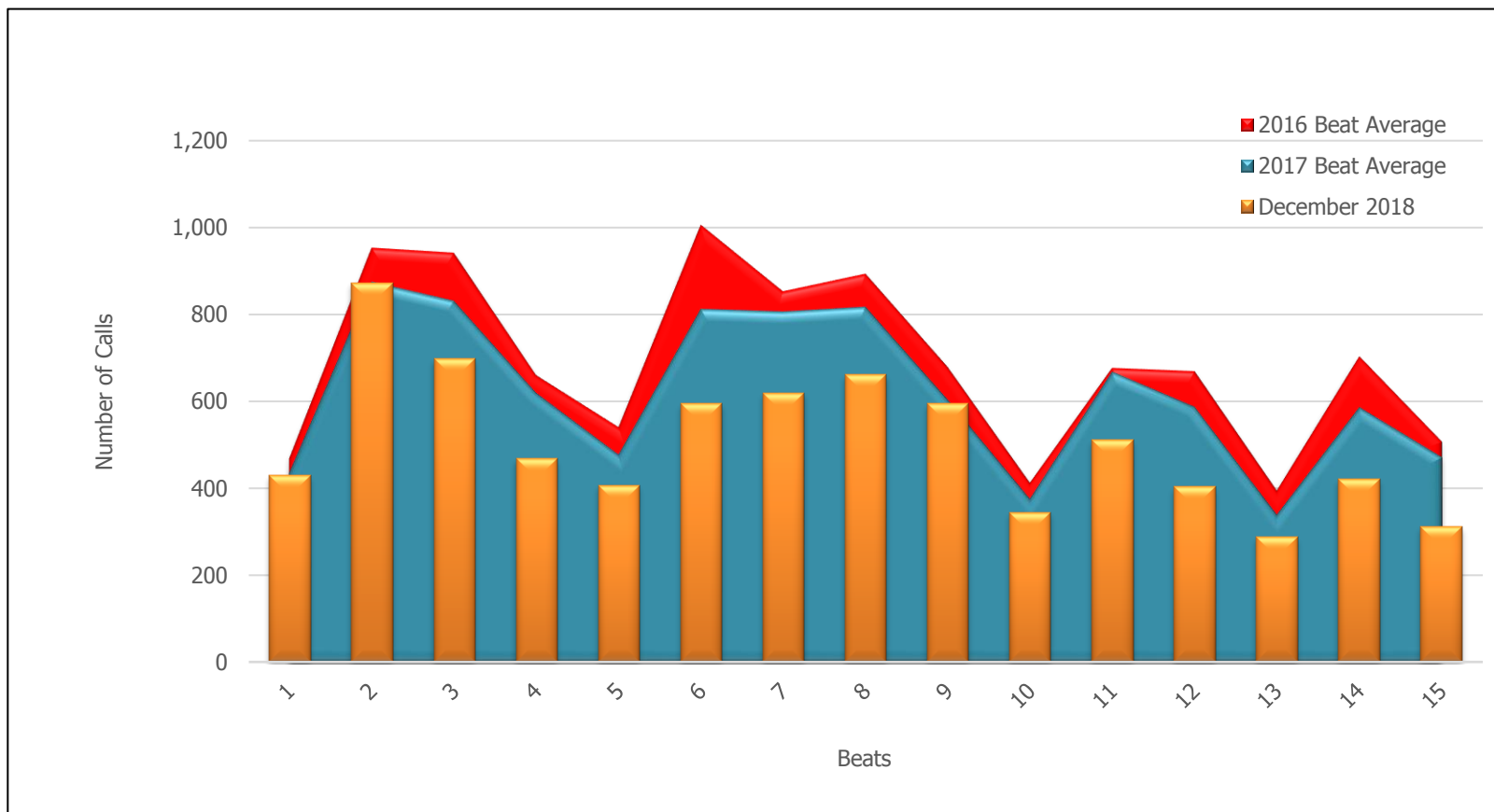
Calls for Service by Month

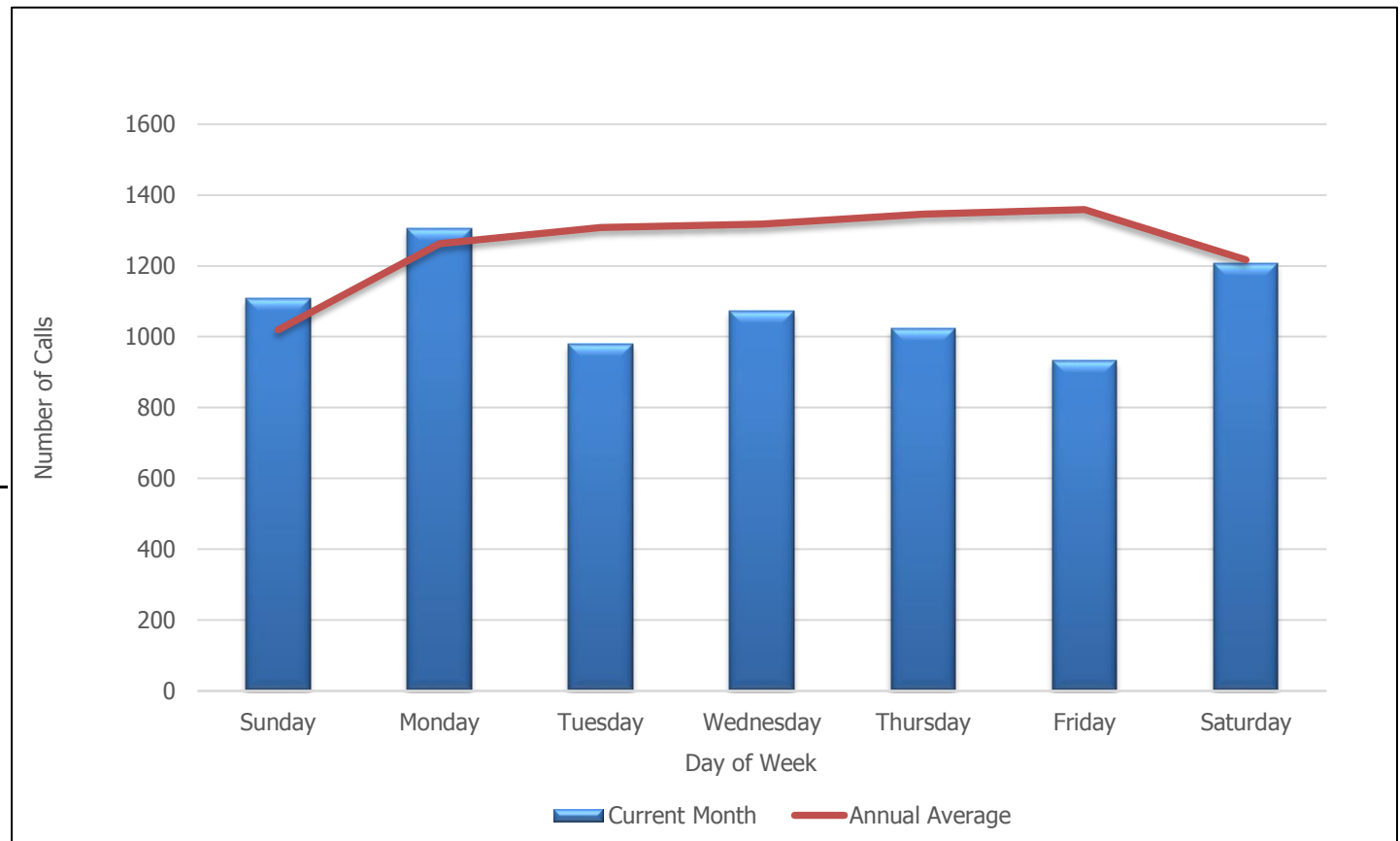

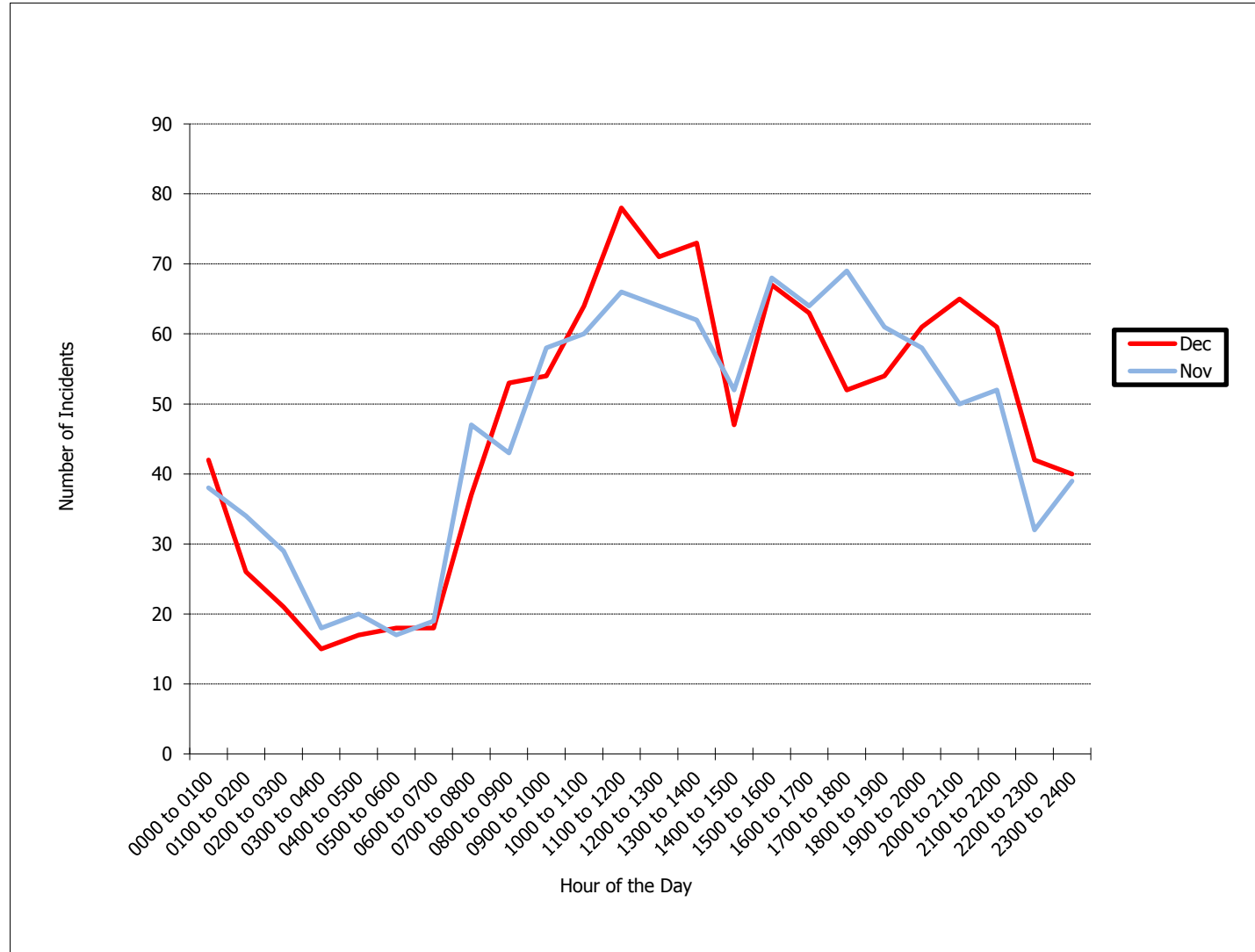

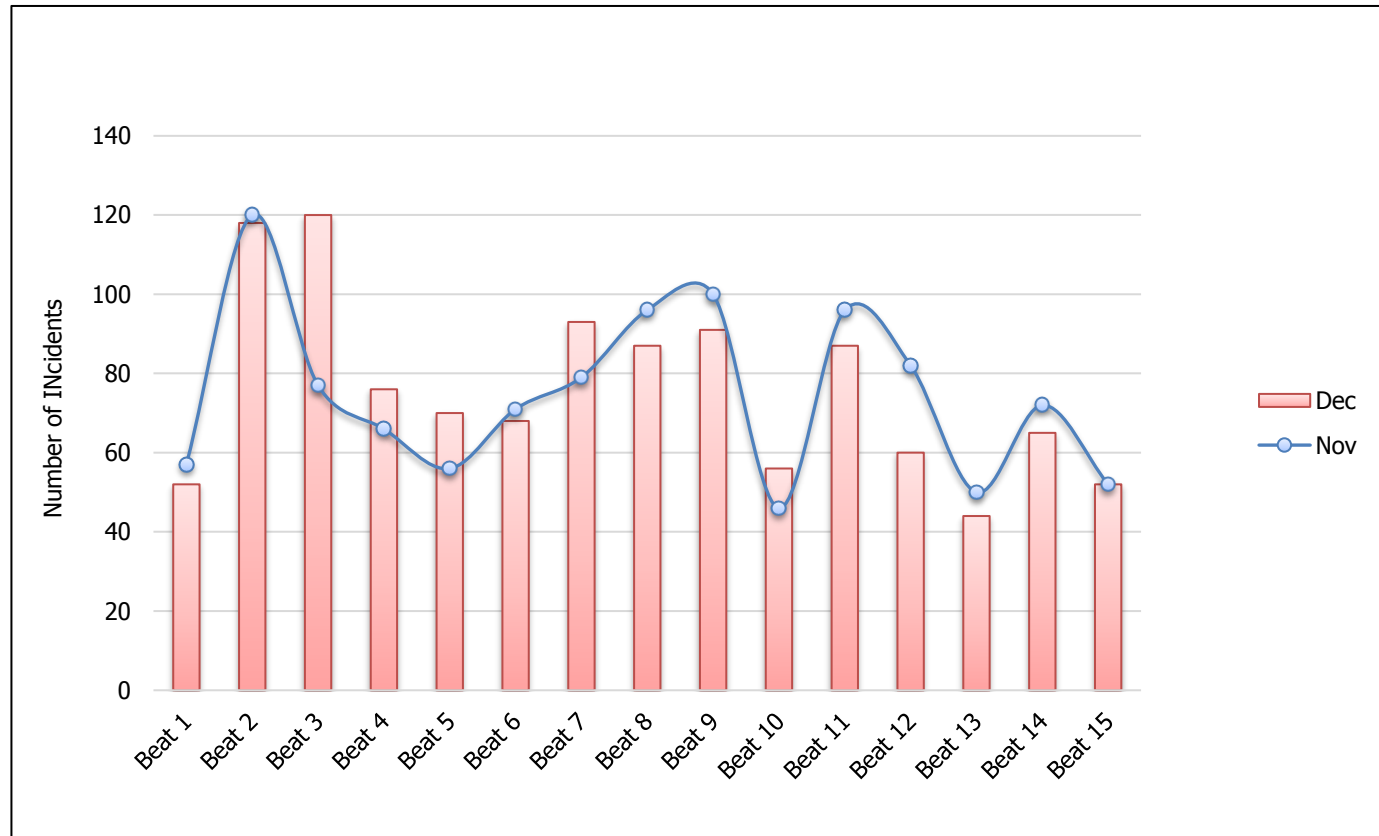

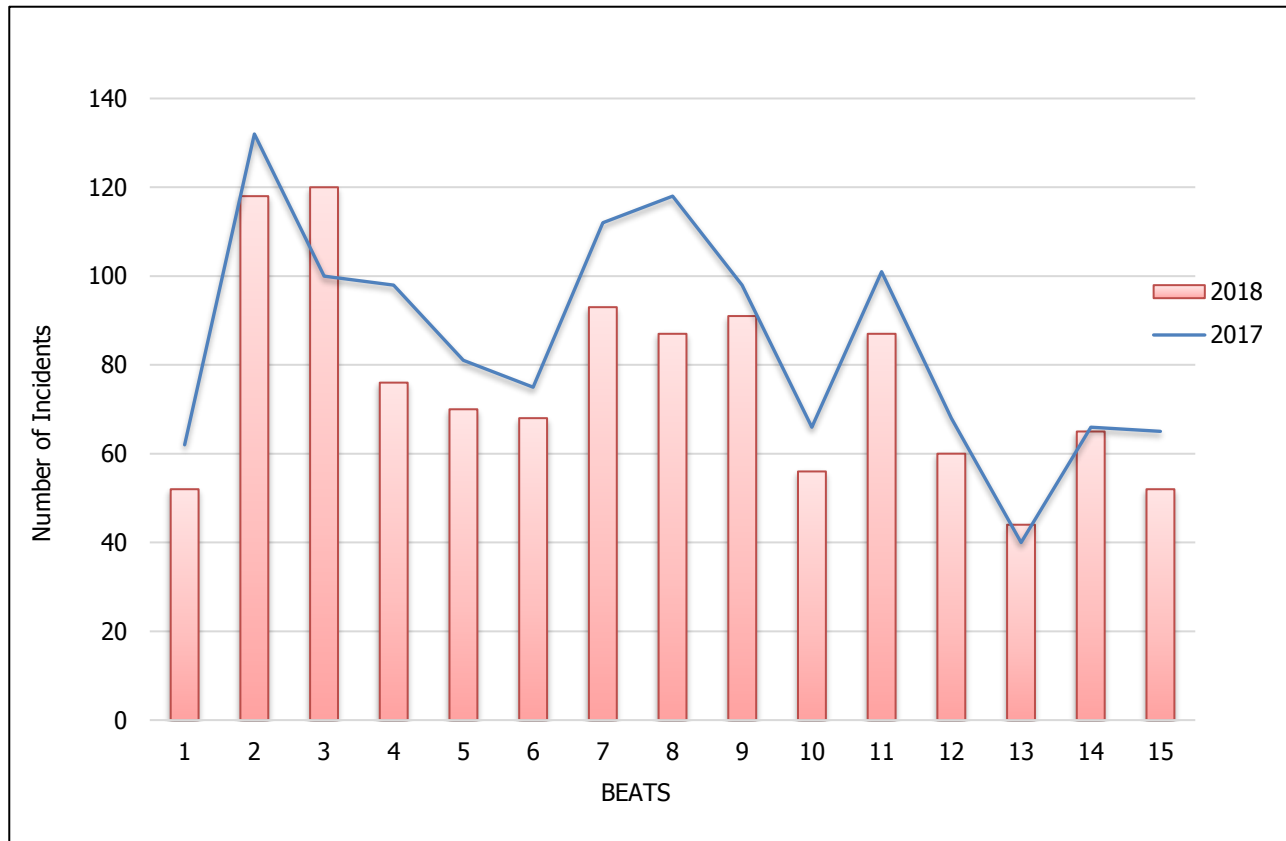

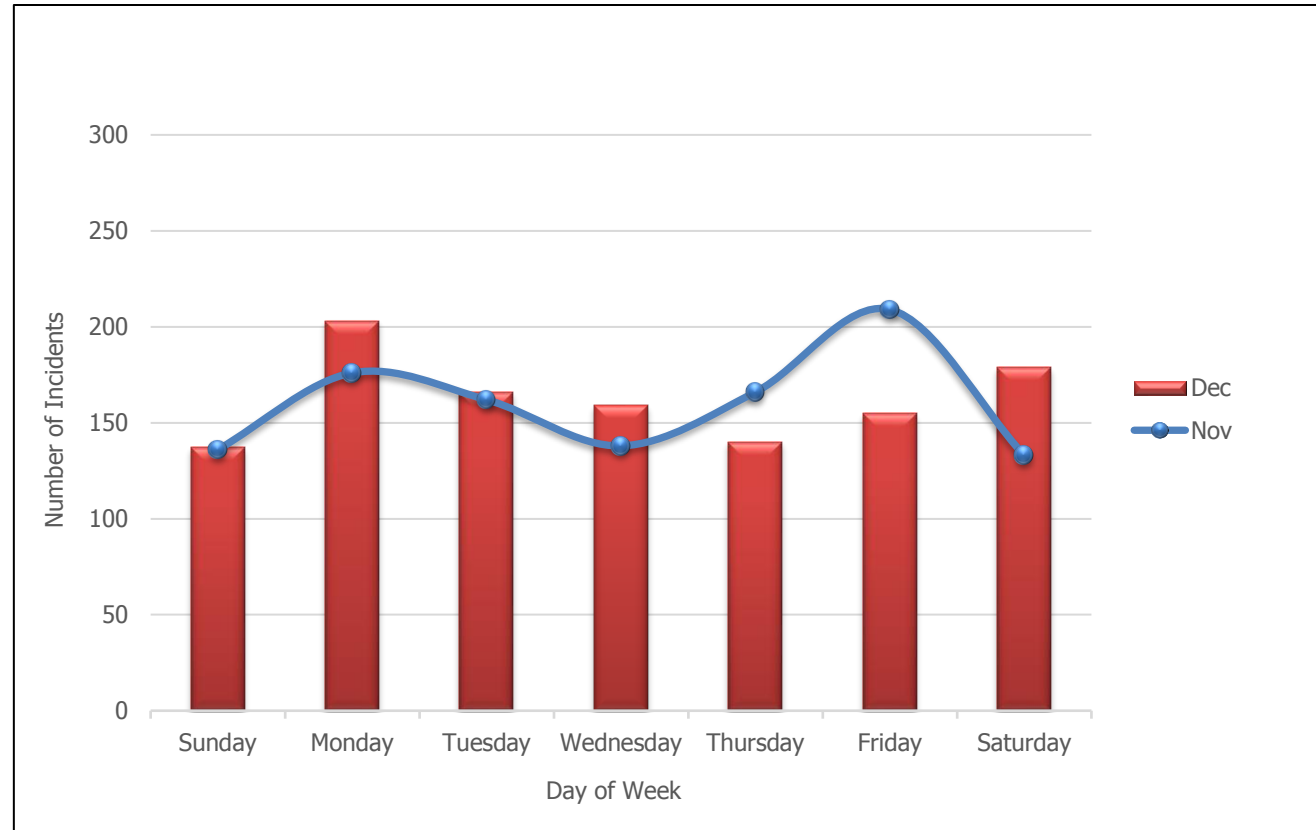

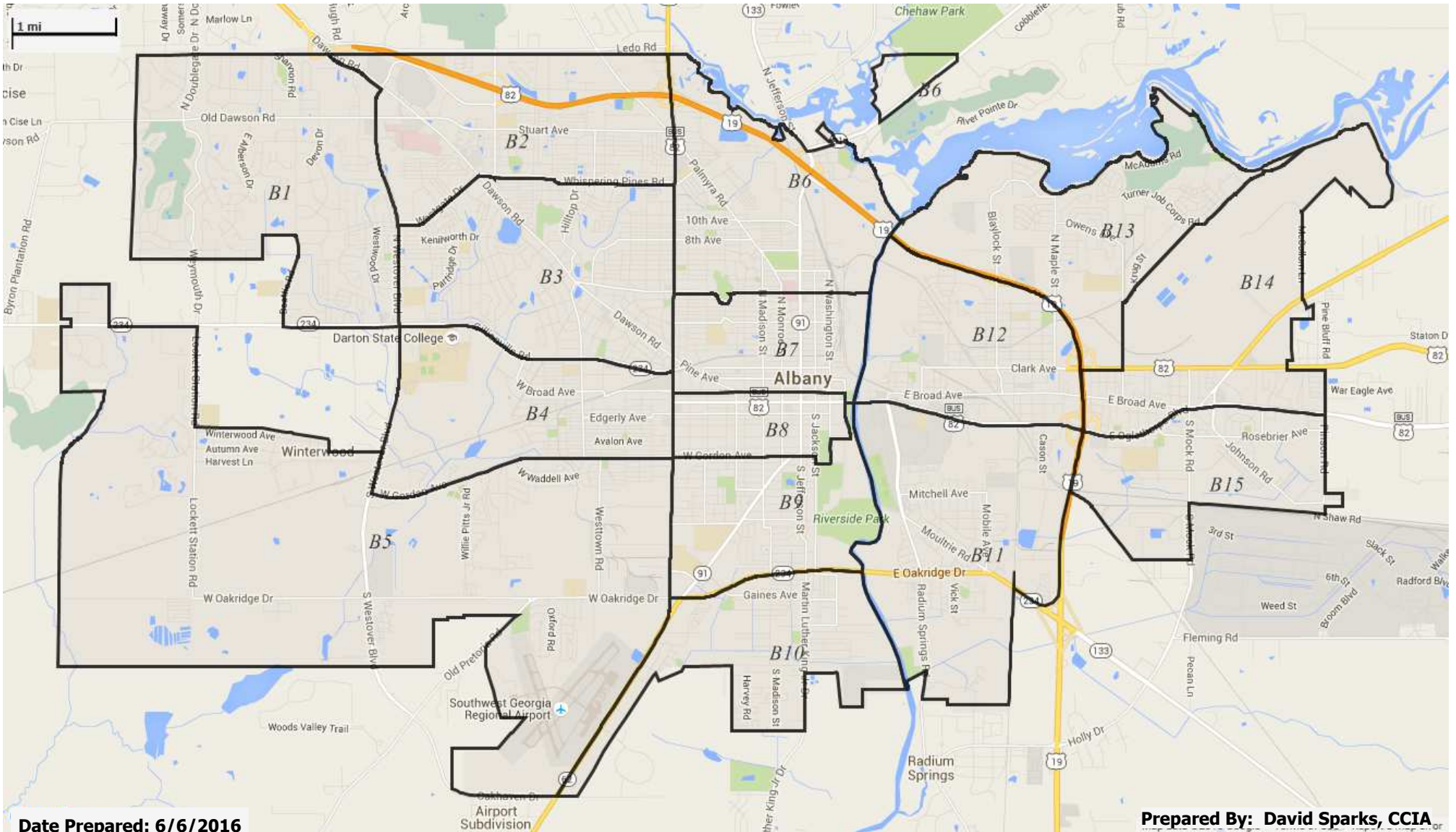
