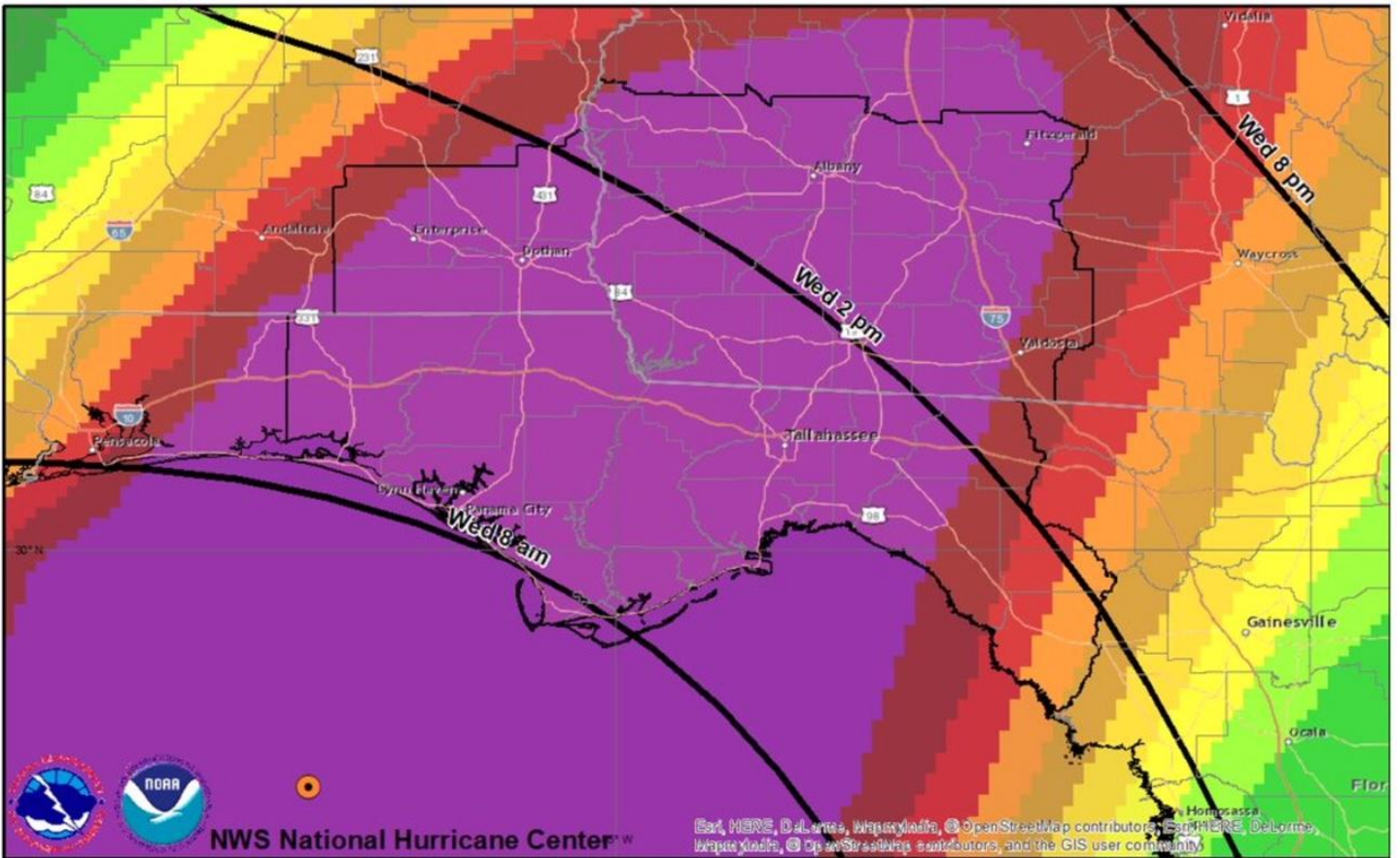


Hurricane Michael Weather Update - October 10, 2018, 11 AM

Current Forecast & Key Local Information:

- Governor Nathan Deal has declared a State of Emergency for 92 Georgia Counties, including Dougherty County.
- Dougherty County has issued a local State of Emergency.
- Hurricane Warnings are in effect across much of the region, including Dougherty County.
- There is a Tornado Watch in effect for Dougherty County until 5pm tonight.
- **Shelters**
 - Albany Family Worship Center at 3024 Kensington Ct
 - Bethesda Baptist Church, 6411 Newton Road, 229-483-1903
 - Pine Bluff Baptist Church, 499 Pine Bluff Road
 - Unless you live in a mobile home, the recommendation is to seek a local shelter, or one of the Georgia state sponsored out of area shelters. The EOC cannot guarantee transportation, but asks that residents call the information line to check for transportation assistance.
- **Closures**
 - All Dougherty County offices and buildings are closed today and tomorrow.
 - Southwest Public Health District, as well as, Dougherty County Public Health are closed today and tomorrow.
 - Dougherty Counties Schools are closed today and tomorrow.
- All Public Safety operations will cease, once sustained winds reach 35 mph.
- The Dougherty County EOC is activated and will operate on a 24 hour basis, for the duration of the event.
- The EOC Information lines are open. Information line numbers are: 229.483.6226 and 229.483.6227.
- If you have a life-threatening emergency, call 9-1-1
- The next planned update is 1600, Wednesday, October 10th.

 Cumulative Probability > 39 mph Sustained Winds



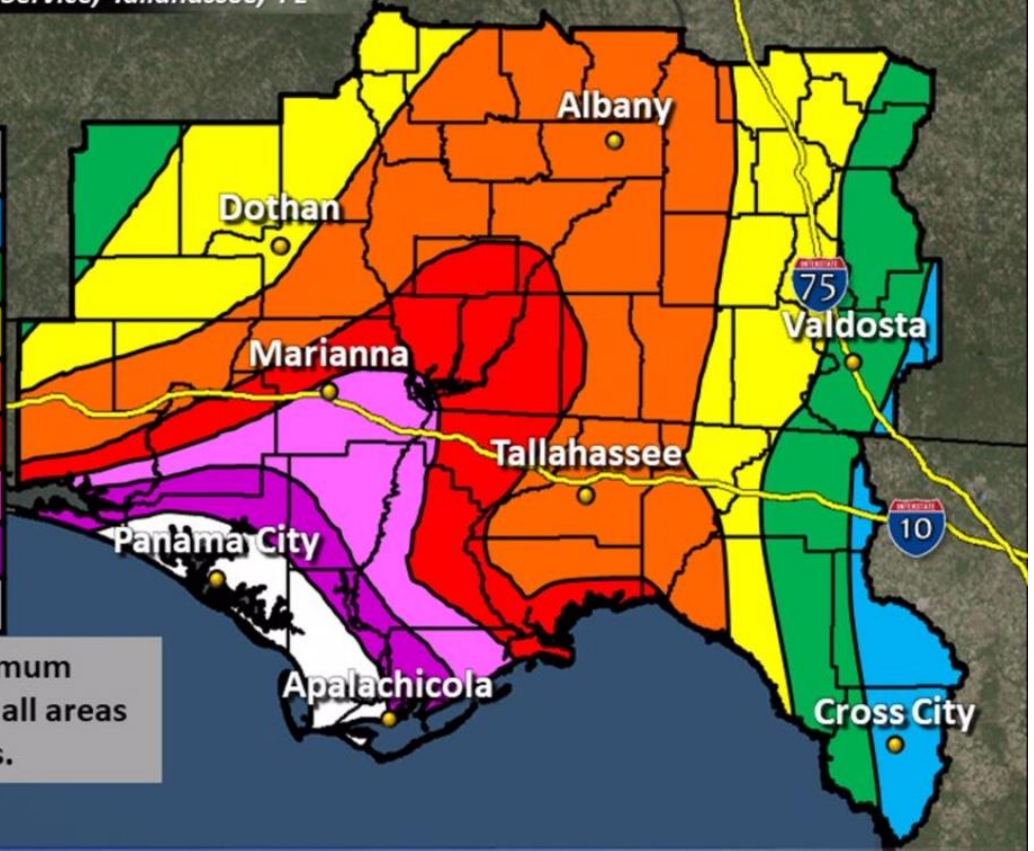


Potential Peak Wind Gusts during Michael

Peak Wind Gust Speed
50 mph to 60 mph
60 mph to 73 mph
74 mph to 85 mph
85 mph to 95 mph
95 mph to 110 mph
111 mph to 129 mph
130 mph to 155 mph
>156 mph

Note: These are the maximum wind gusts expected. Not all areas will see these peak values.



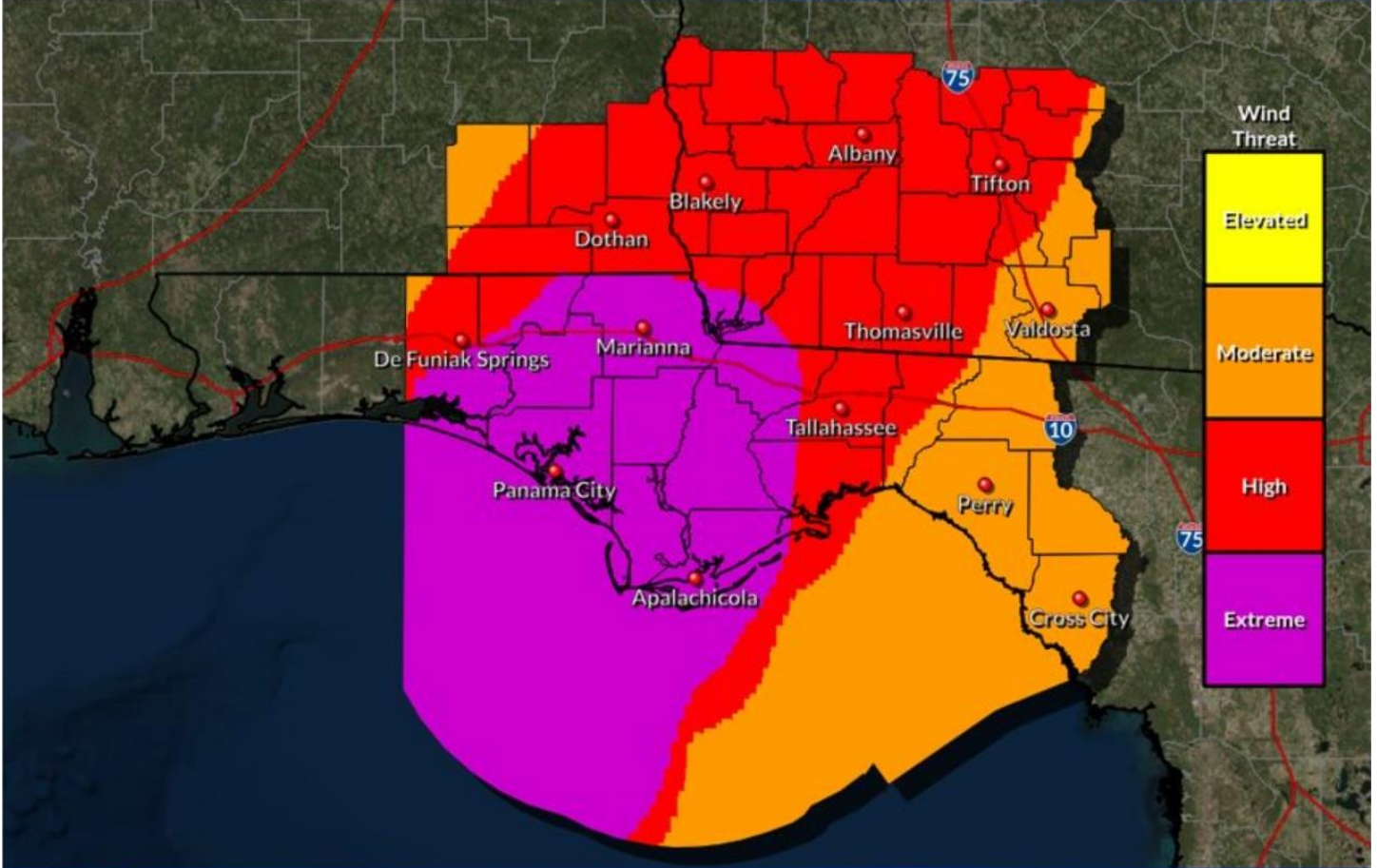

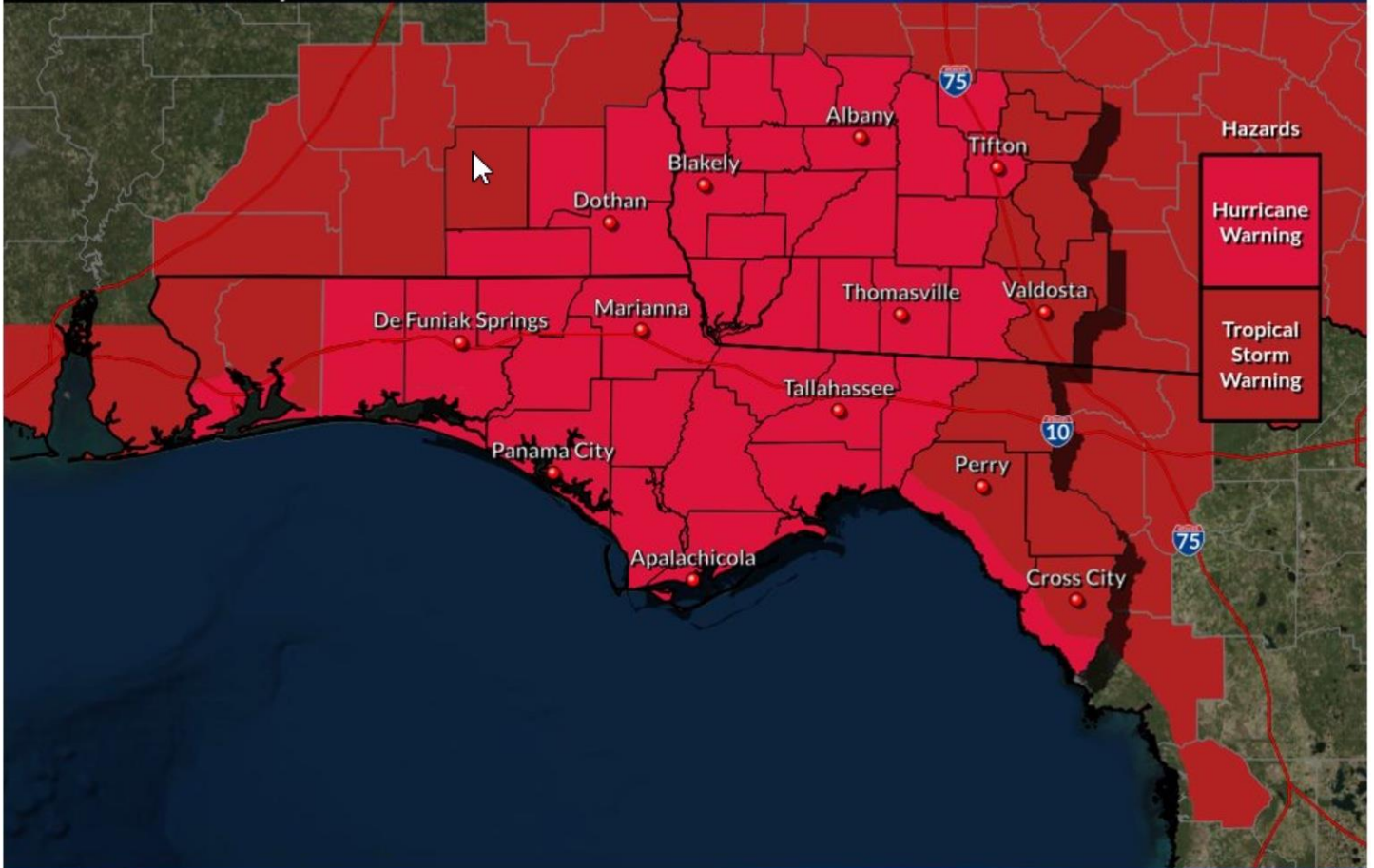

Rainfall from Michael

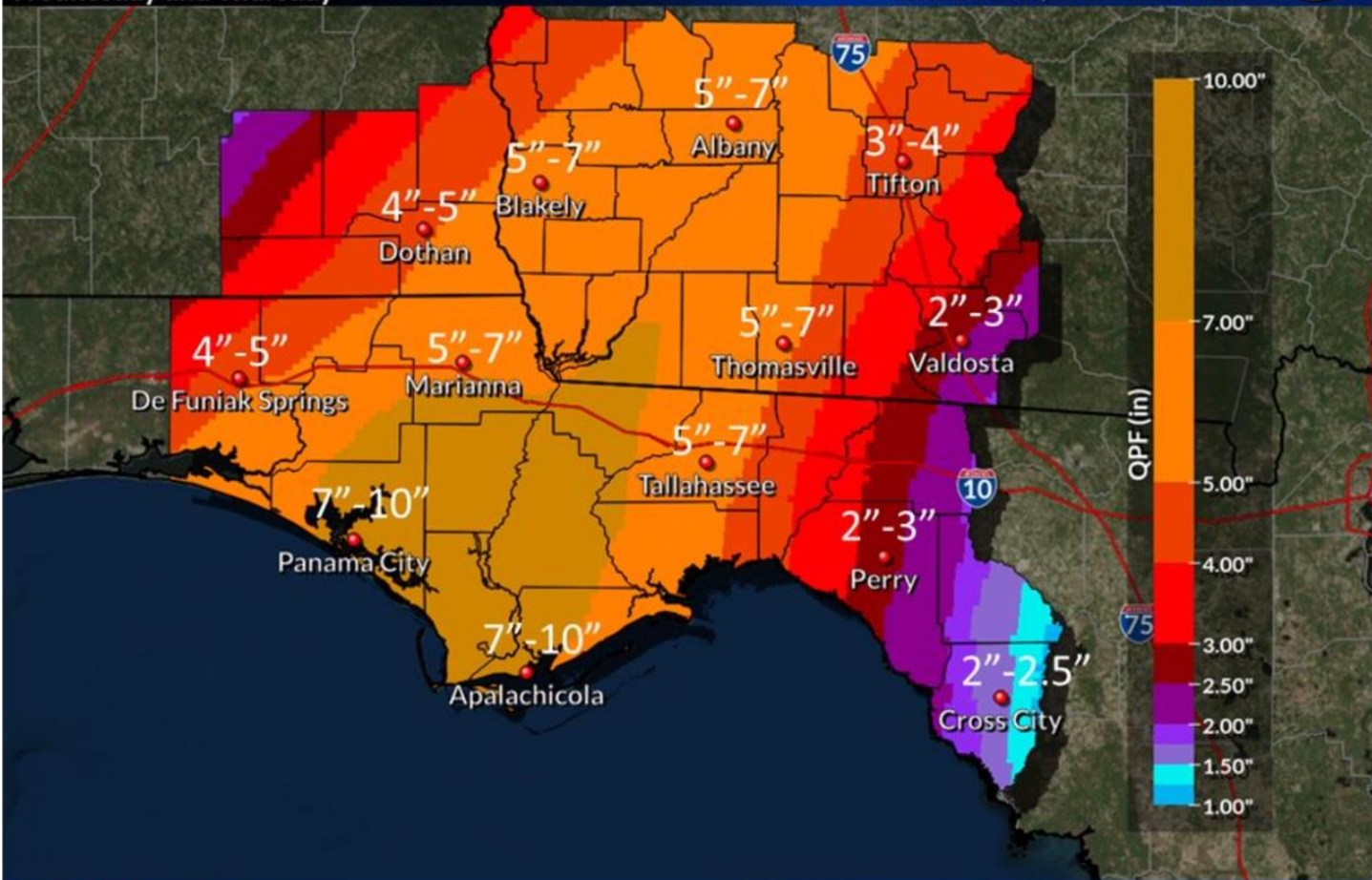
