Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Albany, Procurement Division, Suite 260, 222 Pine Avenue, Albany, Georgia, on behalf of the Dougherty County Board of Commissioners, until **2:30 p.m. on June 4, 2019**, for Traffic Sign Repair, at various locations throughout the City of Albany, in accordance with bid documents, specifications, and all other contract documents.

A **Pre-Bid Conference** will be held on **May 15, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.** at 222 Pine Avenue Suite 260 Albany, GA 31701. A member of Procurement staff and the Project Manager will be available to provide an overview of the work to be performed and answer questions.

This project will be bid on a unit price basis for all specified work and will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

5% Bid Bond is required of all bidders. Bid bond must be present for bid to be read or considered. This is a unit price bid to be awarded as one project for all specified work. Bid will be awarded to the responsive and responsible bidder submitting the lowest bid.

Bid documents are available at the Procurement Division, www.albanyga.gov, and the Georgia Procurement Registry. Plans, specifications and contract documents may be inspected at the Procurement Division, 222 Pine Avenue, and the Dougherty County Public Works Department, 2038 Newton Road, Albany, Georgia. The City of Albany and Dougherty County strongly encourage Small Business firms to participate in this bid. Dougherty County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding process.

All Corporations should provide corporate seal, a copy of the Secretary of State's Certificate of Incorporation, and a listing of the principals of the corporation with the bid.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

These instructions will bind bidders to terms and conditions herein set forth, except as specifically qualified in special bid and contract terms issued with any individual bid.

1. The following criteria are used in determining low responsible bidder.
 - (a) The ability, capacity and skill of bidder to perform required service.
 - (b) Whether bidder can perform service promptly or within specified time.
 - (c) The character, integrity, reputation, judgment, experience and efficiency of bidder.
 - (d) The performance of previous contracts.
 - (e) The suitability of equipment or material for County use.
 - (f) The ability of bidder to provide future maintenance and parts service.
2. Payment terms are Net 30 unless otherwise specified. Favorable term discounts may be offered and will be considered in determining low bids if they are deemed advantageous to the County.
3. All bids should be tabulated, totaled and checked for accuracy. The unit price will prevail in case of errors.
4. All requested information should be included in bid envelope. All desired information must be **signed** and included for your bid to receive full consideration. **Failure to submit any required form will be cause for bid to be rejected as non-responsive.**
5. All questions, inquiries and requests for clarification shall be directed to Procurement.
6. For multi-year contracts the following clauses pursuant to OCGA 36-60-13 apply: (1) The contract shall terminate absolutely and without further obligation on the part of the County at the close of the calendar year in which it was executed and at the close of each succeeding calendar year for which it may be renewed; (2) The contract may provide for automatic renewal unless positive action is taken by the County to terminate such contract, and the nature of such action shall be determined by the County and specified in the contract; (3) The contract shall state the total obligation of the County for the calendar year of execution and shall further state the total obligation which will be incurred in each calendar year renewal term, if renewed; and (4) The contract shall provide that title to any supplies, materials, equipment, or other personal property shall remain in the vendor until fully paid for by the County.
7. Quote all prices F.O.B. Albany, Georgia or our warehouse or as specified in bid documents.
8. Each bid or proposal shall be clearly marked on the outside of the envelope as a Sealed Bid whether using a County furnished envelope or other envelopes.
9. Bid/Proposal must be received and stamped by the Procurement Office before time stipulated in bid/proposal documents. No responsibility will attach to any County representative or employee for premature opening of bid not properly addressed or identified.
10. If only one bid is received, the bid may be rejected and/or re-advertised, except in the case of only one known source of supply.
11. Bids received late will not be accepted, and the County will not be responsible for late mail delivery.
12. Should a bid be misplaced by the County and found later it will be considered.
13. Bids requiring bid bonds **will not** be read or considered if bond is not enclosed. Bond may be in the form of cash, certified check, cashier's check or Surety Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to conduct business in Georgia.
14. All bidders must be recognized and authorized dealers in the materials or equipment specified and be qualified to advise in their application or use. A bidder at any time requested must satisfy the Procurement Office and County Commission that he has the requisite organization, capital, plant, stock, ability and experience to satisfactorily execute the contract in accordance with the provisions of the contract in which he is interested.
15. Any alterations, erasures, additions or omissions of required information or any changes of specifications, or bidding schedule are done at the risk of the bidder. Any bid will be rejected that has a substantial variation, such as a variation that affects the price, quality or delivery date (when delivery is required by a specific time).
16. When requested, SAMPLES will be furnished free of expense, properly marked for identification and accompanied by list where there is more than one sample. The County reserves the right to mutilate or destroy any samples submitted whenever it may be in the best interests of the County to do so for the purpose of testing.
17. County will reject any material, supplies or equipment that do not meet the specifications, even though bidder lists the trade name or names of such materials on the bid or price quotation form.
18. The unauthorized use of patented articles is done entirely at the risk of the successful bidder.
19. The ESTIMATED QUANTITY given in the specifications or advertisement is for the purpose of bidding only. The County may purchase more or less than the estimated quantity, and the vendor must not assume that such estimated quantity is part of the contract.
20. Only the latest model equipment as evidenced by the manufacturer's current published literature, will be considered. Obsolete models of equipment not in production will not be acceptable. Equipment shall be composed of new parts and materials. Any unit containing used parts or having seen any service other than the necessary tests will be rejected. In addition to the equipment specifically called for in the specifications, all equipment catalogued by the manufacturer as standard or required by the State of Georgia shall be furnished with the equipment. Where required by the State of Georgia Motor Vehicle Code, vehicles shall be inspected and bear the latest inspection sticker of the Georgia Department of Revenue.
21. The successful bidder on motor vehicle equipment shall be required to furnish with delivery of vehicle, Certificate of Origin and Georgia vendors shall provide Georgia Motor Vehicle form MV1.

22. Prospective bidders are responsible for examining the location of the proposed work or delivery and determining, in their own way, the difficulties, which are likely to be encountered in the prosecution of the same.
23. All materials, equipment and supplies shall be subject to rigid inspection, under the immediate supervision of the Procurement Office and/or the Department to which they are delivered. If defective material, equipment or supplies are discovered, the contractor, upon being instructed by the Procurement Office, shall remove, or make good such material, equipment or supplies without extra compensation. It is expressly understood and agreed that the inspection of materials by the County will in no way lessen the responsibility of the contractor or release him from his obligation to perform and deliver to the County sound and satisfactory materials, equipment or supplies. The contractor agrees to pay the cost of all tests on defective material, equipment or supplies or allow the cost to be deducted from any monies due him by the County.
24. Unless otherwise specified by the procurement office all materials, supplies or equipment quoted herein must be delivered within thirty (30) days from date of notification or exception noted on bid sheet.
25. A contract **will not** be awarded to any corporation, firm or individual who is, from any cause, in arrears to the County or who has failed in any former contract with the County to perform work satisfactorily, either as to the character of the work, the fulfillment of the guarantee, or the time consumed in completing the work.
26. Reasonable grounds for supposing that any bidder is interested in more than one proposal/bid for the same item will be considered sufficient cause for rejection of all bids/proposals in which he is interested.
27. Unless otherwise specified the County reserves the right to award each item separately or on a lump sum basis, whichever is in the best interest of the County.
28. The County reserves the right to waive any minor discrepancies, reject any or all bids or proposals, and to purchase any part, all or none of the services, materials, supplies or equipment specified.
29. Failure of the bidder to sign the bid or have the signature of any authorized representative or agent on the bid/proposal **IN THE SPACE PROVIDED will** be cause for rejection of the bid. Signature must be written in ink.
30. Any bidder may withdraw his bid at any time before the time set for opening of bids. No bid may be withdrawn without cause in the 60-day period after bids are opened.
31. It is mutually understood and agreed that if any time the Procurement Office shall be of the opinion that the contract or any part thereof is unnecessarily delayed or that the rate of progress or delivery is unsatisfactory, or that the contractor is willfully violating any of the conditions or covenants of the agreement, or is executing the same in bad faith, the Procurement Office shall have the power to notify the aforesaid contractor of the nature of the complaint. Notification shall constitute delivery of notice, or letter, to address given in bid/proposal. If after three working days of notification the conditions are not corrected to the satisfaction of the Procurement Office, he shall thereupon have the power to take whatever action he may deem necessary to complete the work or delivery herein described, or any part thereof, and the expense thereof, so charged, shall be deducted from any paid by the County out of such monies as may become due to the said contractor, under and by virtue of this agreement. In case such expense shall exceed the last said sum, then and in that event, the bondsman or the contractor, his executors, administrators, successors, or assigns, shall pay the amount of such excess to the County on notice by the Procurement Office of the excess due.
32. If the bidder proposes to furnish any item of a foreign make or product, he should write "Foreign" together with the name of the originating country opposite such item on bid/proposal.
33. Any complaint from bidders relative to the Invitation to Bid or any attached specifications should be made prior to the time of opening of bids, otherwise such complaint cannot be properly considered.
34. No vendor writing restrictive specifications for the County will be allowed to bid on the project.
35. Contracts may be cancelled by the County with or without cause with 30-day written notice.
36. Dougherty County has an equal opportunity purchasing policy. The County seeks to ensure that all segments of the business community have access to supplying the goods and services needed by the County programs. The County affirmatively works to encourage utilization of minority business enterprises in our procurement activities. The County provides equal opportunities for all businesses and does not discriminate against any vendors regardless of race, color, religion, age, sex, national origin, or handicap.
37. **All Corporations must provide the corporate seal and a copy of the Secretary of State's Certificate of Incorporation upon request.**
38. Local bidder (domiciled in Dougherty County) will receive bid in the event of tie bids. In the case of tie bids between out of town companies or between local concerns, evaluated as equal, bid will be recommended or awarded by chance coin toss, or drawing straws.
39. The contractor shall secure all permits, license certificates, inspections (permanent and temporary) and occupational tax certificate, if applicable, before any work can commence. Contractor as well as any and all known subcontractors must possess or will be required to obtain a City of Albany Occupational Tax Certificate or Registration.

General Information: Replacement of signs, installation of new signs and/or the installation of new sign posts at locations in unincorporated Dougherty County due to damage caused by Hurricane Michael.

2. Contractor's bid shall include all necessary labor, materials, tools, equipment, and all other items necessary to complete the contract requirements in accordance with specifications, general conditions, special instructions to bidders and all other provisions included in this invitation to bid.
3. **Interpretation of Estimate of Quantities:**
 - A. An estimate of quantities of work to be done and materials to be furnished under the specifications is given in the bid. It is given as a basis for comparison of bids and the award of the Contract. The Owner does not expressly or by implication agree that the actual quantities involved will correspond therewith; nor shall the bidder plead misunderstanding or deception because of such estimate of quantities, or of the character, location or other conditions pertaining to the work.
 - B. Payment will be based on the actual quantities of work performed in accordance with Contract, at the Contract unit prices specified. No allowances will be made for any change in anticipated profits due to an increase or decrease in the original estimate of quantities. The Owner reserves the right to omit any item entirely, or to increase or decrease any or all items.
 - C. Bidder shall be responsible to visit the job site and familiarize himself with the local conditions.
4. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days from the bid opening date.
5. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding process.
6. The Owner of this project is the Dougherty County.
7. **Contract Time:** Contract must be completed within **ninety (90) calendar days** following the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. Performance will be monitored and documented by the Project Manager. Not completing this contract within the time specified may hamper the contractor's ability to secure future contracts with the County.
8. **Bid Form:** Bid **must** be submitted on the bid form provided by Dougherty County. Bid will be awarded to the responsive and responsible bidder submitting the lowest total bid.
9. **Qualifications:** The Contractor for this Project **must** provide signs, sign fabrication, sign posts, anchors, hardware, panels, reflectorizing materials, and sign paint that meets GDOT specifications.
10. **Insurance:** The bidder shall possess and maintain general liability coverage of at least \$1,000,000 combined single limit with \$2,000,000 general aggregate per occurrence covering all premises and operations including bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage. In addition to the Certificate of Insurance, the contractor must provide the declaration page for the commercial general liability insurance policy. Policy shall be endorsed to name Dougherty County as an

additional insured, provide thirty (30) days' notice of any cancellation, modification, and/or alteration of the coverage, and specifically identify the project being insured.

The bidder shall possess and maintain **worker's compensation** coverage in the statutory limits of Georgia.

The bidder shall possess and maintain **Business Automobile Liability** of \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit covering owned, non-owned and hired automobiles.

Submit with Bid, specimen copy of Certificate of Insurance. Upon award of contract and prior to commencement of work under this contract, the successful bidder shall provide Dougherty County a Certificate of Insurance showing the type and limits of insurance specified herein with Dougherty County Board of Commissioners as an additional insurer.

11. **Indemnity Agreement:** An executed copy of this form should accompany your bid and must be completed for contract award. (See attached).
12. **Governing Law & Venue:** An executed copy of this form should accompany your bid. (See attached).
13. **Certificate of Non-Collusion:** An executed copy of this form should accompany your bid. (See attached).
14. **Permits & Fees:** Within **five (5) days** following the issuance of the Notice to Proceed, the contractor shall apply for all permits. Failure to do so may result in award of this contract to the next lowest bidder and the original contractor may be billed for the difference in price. The contractor shall secure all permits, license certificates, inspections (permanent and temporary) and occupational tax certificate(s) before any work can commence. This documentation should be on file in the Procurement Office prior to the start of any work associated with this contract. **The contractor is required to contact the Project Engineer, Jeremy Brown at 229-430-6120 within five (5) days of completion for a final inspection.** Contractor as well as any and all known subcontractors must possess or will be required to obtain a City of Albany Occupational Tax Certificate or Registration **prior** to commencement of work.
15. **Compliance:** The contractor is responsible for knowledge of and compliance with all laws, codes, ordinances, and regulations that are applicable to this type of work.
16. **Superintendent:** The contractor shall have a superintendent or representative on the site at all times while work is being performed. He will represent the contractor and all communications given to him shall be binding as if given to the contractor.
17. **Preservation of Property:** The contractor shall carry out his work with such care and by the proper methods to prevent damage to the property adjacent to the work or within streets, easement locations to the extent the owner may have rights therein, or other property of the owners or of others, whether adjacent to the work site or not, the removal, relocation, or destruction of which is not called for by the provisions of the contract documents; it being a condition of the execution of the contract that the work be performed in such manner that the property of others and other property of the owner shall not be damaged in any way. The word PROPERTY, as used, is intended to include among other types of property, public street improvements, storm and sanitary sewers, water lines and appurtenances, or other structures. Should any property be damaged or destroyed, the contractor at his own expense shall promptly, or within reasonable time, repair or make such restoration as is practical and acceptable to the owner of the damaged or destroyed property. In case of failure on the part of the contractor to repair or restore such property, or make good such damage or injury, the Building Inspector may within forty-eight (48) hours notice, proceed to repair, rebuild, or otherwise restore such property as may be necessary, and the cost thereof will be deducted from any monies due or which may become due the contractor under this contract

agreement. The contractor shall, at all times in performance of the work, employ approved methods and exercise reasonable care and skill so as to avoid delay, damage, injury or destruction of existing public service installations and structures; and shall at all times in the performance of the work avoid interference with, or interruption of, public utilities services, and shall cooperate fully with the owners thereof to the end.

18. **Public Convenience and Safety:** Fire hydrants on or adjacent to the street shall be kept accessible to the fire apparatus at all times and no material or obstructions shall be placed within ten (10) feet of any hydrant. Materials shall not be stored along the streets. Traffic on streets shall be maintained at all times.
19. **Barricades and Warnings:** The contractor shall provide erect and maintain all necessary barricades, suitable and sufficient number of watchmen to direct traffic, and take all necessary precautions for the protection of the work and safety of the public. Barricades and obstructions shall be illuminated at night and lights shall be kept burning from sunset to sunrise. All necessary traffic control measures shall be included in unit prices as any incidental item.
20. **Removal of Trash and Rubbish:** The contractor shall be responsible for the removal and legal disposal of all waste, trash, and rubbish resulting from the work under this contract. Work site shall be kept clean and orderly during construction; trash shall be removed from the site or adequately containerized daily. All damaged signs and posts shall be disposed of or recycled, by the Contractor, legally at a certified, permitted landfill or facility.
21. **Pre-Bid Conference:** A pre-bid conference will be held on **May 15, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.** at 222 Pine Avenue Suite 260 Albany, GA 31701. **All interested bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.**
22. **Termination for Convenience:** This contract may be terminated in whole or in part by Dougherty County with the consent of the contractor in which case the two parties shall agree upon the termination conditions, including the effective date in the case of partial termination, the portion to be terminated or by the contractor upon written notification to Dougherty County setting forth the reasons for such termination, the effective date, and in the case of partial termination, the portion to be terminated. However, if in the case of partial termination, Dougherty County determines that the remaining portion of the award will not accomplish the purposes for which the contract was awarded, Dougherty County may terminate the contract in its entirety.
23. **Certification of Bidder's Experience and Qualifications:** The undersigned bidder certifies that he is, at the time of bidding, and shall be, throughout the period of the contract, licensed by the State of Georgia to do the type of work required under terms of the contract documents. Bidder further certifies that he is skilled and regularly engaged in the general class and type of work called for in the contract documents. The bidder represents that he is competent, knowledgeable and has special skills on the nature, extent, and inherent conditions of the work to be performed. Bidder further acknowledges that there are certain peculiar and inherent conditions existent in the construction of the particular facilities, which may create, during the construction program, unusual or peculiar unsafe conditions hazardous to persons and property. Bidder expressly acknowledges that he has the skill and experience to foresee and to adopt protective measures to adequately and safely perform the construction work with respect to such hazards.
24. **Corporations:** All Corporations should provide corporate seal, a copy of the Secretary of State's Certificate of Incorporation, and a listing of the principals of the corporation with the bid.
25. **Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act:** The successful contractor will provide certification that he is in compliance with the Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act, certifying that the provisions of GA Law, O.C.G.A 13-10-91, Chapter 300-10-1, per the Georgia Department of Labor, if applicable, have been complied with in full. Pursuant to O.C.G.A 13-10-

90(2), all subcontractors entering into a contract or agreement for hire on this Project must be registered and participate in the Federal Work Authorization Program. **Complete and submit a copy of the form, applicable to your company, and applicable Subcontractor Affidavits, with your bid.**

26. ***The successful bidder agrees to adhere to the Federal Laws as stated in 2 C.F.R. 200.326 as described in Appendix II to Part 200 – Contract Provisions for non-Federal Entity Contracts Under Federal Awards, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide, and any other Federal rules, regulations or policy relating to disaster services.***

SCOPE OF WORK

Scope of Sign Repair and Installation: The contractor will replace damaged or missing signs, reinstall signs, and/or install new sign posts at locations within the unincorporated areas of Dougherty County as a result of storm damage incurred during Hurricane Michael. When a sign is replaced, the replacement sign will be High-Intensity Prismatic (HIP). All signs and materials should meet the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) standards and specifications for manufacturing and installation. The quantities provided are ESTIMATES and offered to assist bidders. A preliminary sign assessment spreadsheet is attached showing known damaged signs. A location map containing the signs is not available. The contractor will be responsible for verifying all quantities for this project. Existing damaged signs and posts will be removed and disposed of, upon installation of new materials. Each sign site will have, before and after the repair, photos taken with GEO position locations embedded in the image. Apps similar to "Solocator" are preferred. The contractor will provide a minimum of two electronic images for each sign or post repair. A written report documenting existing conditions, repairs, and materials used shall be provided in both electronic and printed format.

FEMA funding will support this project. The contractor will be responsible for gathering and providing all documentation required for Federal Reporting of this project, such as Davis Bacon.

The most current GDOT specifications will be used for the minimum requirements:

1. Highway Signs - Section 636
2. Sign Fabrication – Section 910
3. Sign Post – Section 911 (TP-7 square posts)
4. Sign Blanks and Panels – Section 912
5. Reflectorizing Materials – Section 913
6. Sign Paint – Section 914

Supplemental Information:

1. All street name signs shall be 9" high blades and the length will be determined based on the number of words and letters in the name. Two single sided signs mounted directly to the post, for each name, is acceptable; however, the labor payment for this method will only be counted as one sign.

Work Required:	For all labor, equipment, and materials necessary for mobilization, demobilization, bonds & insurance required for a complete job.

Description: Install New Post, Reinstall existing sign(s)

Measurement: Per each post installed where existing sign(s) are to be transferred from existing post to new post. Payment for actual post will be paid under linear foot bid price for "signposts with hardware".
Work Required: Installation of a new sign post, regardless of length. All undamaged signs shall be transferred from old post to new post. All damaged items (posts) shall be removed and properly disposed of. Item includes any number for existing signs requiring transfer. Includes all necessary labor, equipment and incidental items necessary to complete the job.

Description: Install New Sign on existing post
Payment: Each
Measurement: Per each new sign installed on existing, undamaged post. Payment for actual sign will be paid for under the square footage bid price for "Signs".
Work Required: Installation of a new sign on an existing post, regardless of sign size. Includes all necessary labor, equipment and incidental items necessary to complete the job. All damaged items (signs) shall be removed and properly disposed of.

Description: Installation of new sign and new post
Payment: Each
Measurement: Per each new sign and new post installed. Payment for actual sign and post will be paid for under the square footage bid price for "Signs" and the linear foot price for "signpost with hardware".
